

# Troop 110 Summer Camp Checklist

(Replaces previous two-part checklist)

## ABOUT THE TRIP AND CAMP

- Pack a brown-bag lunch for trip to camp (troop will have coolers). We stop at rest areas for lunch.
- Spending money for the week (\$40-60) - The Trading Post has food, snacks and scout-related "stuff" to buy. We collect all spending money PRIOR to departure on Saturday. This is deposited in a locked bank. Access is controlled by the adult leaders during the week.
- Return-trip money (\$10-15) for lunch on the way home (fast food)
- Electronics are OK for travel but check with your driver first. These must be left in the vehicle or locked in the trailer during camp.
- Medications are turned in PRIOR to departure on Saturday. Adult leaders dispense these during the week. This is a camp policy and ALL medications are recorded on camp form.
- C.A.R.E. Packages - We recommend mailing them Thursday or Friday prior to camp OR give to leader to put in the trailer and they will pass on to your scout during the week.

## THINGS TO REMEMBER

You are packing for seven days. We recommend packing all clothing in sealed, zip-top bags. Transport your gear in a large duffle bag, footlocker, plastic storage box or trunk.
